Join us for a jobsite tour of the new 1,600 seat concert hall located in Carmel Indiana. The Palladium is scheduled to open in January, 2011. The 118 million dollar concert hall was inspired by a villa designed by Andrea Palladio, built in the 1500s near Vicenza, Italy, the villa is known as "La Rotunda".

The Palladium will serve as an education center and museum for the Michael Feinstein Foundation, housing the rare memorabilia and manuscripts that comprise The Great American Songbook Collection, and it will host an annual international Great American Songbook Festival.
